## WHITE WINE 2019 - Appellation Regional Alentejano

Monte da Raposinha is a family estate focused on a small high quality wine production. Through our wines we want to reflect this unique terroir, honor our family and share happiness.

**Region:** Montargil, Portalegre, Alentejo, PORTUGAL



: At 800m distance, the dam of Montargil is a great influence in the microclimate of the vineyards, increasing humidity and lowering the temperatures. The soil with pebbles contribute to the quality of the grapes.

**Concept:** With the same name of the estate, this wine wants to express in a authentic way the terroir, the grape varieties and the vineyards where they are planted.



: Thought to pair with seafood, fish dishes, sushi and asian food.

**Winemaker:** Paula Bragança

**Grape Varieties:** Arinto (40%), Viosinho (40%) and Antão Vaz (20%)

**Winemaking:** The grapes were hand-harvested, gently destemmed and pressed after being carefully sorted at the winery. Fermentation and aging took place in stainless steel vats with controlled temperature.

**Tasting notes:** Elegant citrus and white flower aromas. On the mouth has crispy acidity, minerality and is very persistent.

**Wine Analysis:** Alcohol 12,5% by volume | Total acid: 7,7 g/L | Final pH: 3,16 |  
Residual sugar: 0,7 g/L

**Total production:** 9.000 bottles of 750ml
